#### NEW SALON APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Please use the following information as a guide when preparing to open a New Salon. Contact your State Cosmetology Inspector to set up your final inspection after you have completely filled out the application and you have obtained all the required signatures. Your Salon Inspectors name and number can be found on the upper left hand corner of the New Salon Application. Print all information that is required & write distinctly in the spaces provided; do NOT leave any blank spaces.

Payment for license with debit or credit will be accepted ONLY with Internet service available at the time of inspection. Applications mailed in to the state board must be accompanied with the correct fee in the form of a cashiers check or money order to the address on the New Salon Application.

All unlicensed owners must have a licensed cosmetologist, nail tech or Esthetician as manager on file at all times, you will be given 10 days to make a manager change, after that time you can be subject to penalties and fines.
